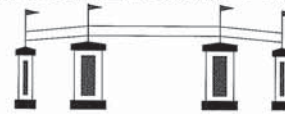

"New" Complete Destruction Demo Derby Official Rules & Regulations – Non-Welded Demo

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS

- If a Driver or Pit Person is "under the age of 18", they must have a waiver of liability signed by parent or legal guardian. **NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 12 IS ALLOWED IN THE PITS!! NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Drivers **MUST** be 16 years old.
- NO deliberate head-ons or hitting opponent's driver door. **AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION.**
- NO SANDBAGGING**, one warning and then you're done.
- NO FEEDING THE DRIVER'S DOOR.**
- NO TEAM DRIVING.**
- The Decision of the **HEAD FLAG MAN** and his **FLAG MAN** are **FINAL.**
- ONLY** the driver will be allowed to approach the **HEAD FLAG MAN** with a disagreement.
- ALL** drivers will attend the drivers' meeting.
- EACH** driver will be allowed **ONE RED FLAG**, Had Flag Man and Safety Personnel will have the **FINAL SAY.**
- LAST** hit counts as the **WIN**, **NOT** necessarily the **LAST ONE RUNNING.**
- ONE MINUTE TIME LIMIT** on any dead or hung up vehicle. After this you will be disqualified.
- PROTEST RULE** – \$50 protest fee to be handed to **TECH OFFICIAL** before he will look at complaint. If complaint is justified to change "money will be refunded", and if found unjustified, "we keep the money".
- GREEN** means **GO** . . . **RED** means **STOP** . . . **BLACK** means **DISQUALIFIED** – "**DONE**".
- ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PITS BY BOTH THE DRIVER AND ANYONE ELSE IN THEIR PIT!** Anyone observed breaking any of these rules will be disqualified and law enforcement will take it from that point.

GENERAL SAFETY AND VEHICLES RULES

- All drivers **MUST** wear seatbelts, helmets, and eye protection at **ALL** times in your vehicle.
- ALL GLASS MUST** be removed including headlights and tail lights.
- The rear seat **MUST** be removed.
- Batteries **MUST** be relocated to a secure area and **COVERED.**
- Radiators and fans may be removed but **NOT** relocated.
- HOODS**
 - Must stay in factory position – "no wrapping of hood"
 - 16" hole to be cut in hood for fire suppression.
- Original Gas Tank **MUST** be removed, and a new tank relocated and placed in Back Seat or Box, with a maximum of 5 gallons.
- Any loose chrome moldings should be removed.
- All Air Bags **MUST** be removed or disconnected.
- NO** fluorescent or red paint to be used on rims or tires.
- ALL** Air Conditioning Refrigerant must be removed.
- Electric fuel pumps are permitted if safely placed and a shut-off switch is accessible and properly marked.
- Transmission coolers are permitted.
- Engines and Bumpers are to remain stock to Vehicle and Year.

- Bumpers and Fenders may be trimmed, but **NOT** altered.
- No special bumpers, extra weights, trailer hitches, lifts, or tire chains are allowed.
- Bumpers must remain at a maximum of 18" to bottom of vehicle.
- NO** welding of shocks.
- Standard tires only – "No Implement Tires" – also remove all wheel weights.
- Hoods, Trunks, and Tailgates** may be secured in 4 Points by using the combination of chains, wire, bolts, or red-rod. Maximum diameter of 1". Red-rod may be welded to the top of the frame or drilled through and bolted. **NO EXTRA WELDING.**
- You may bolt your trimmed fenders and hole cut in your hood with the maximum of "4" "3/8" bolts per location.
- You may add a washer or plate (4" x 4" maximum) to the top of the body bolts.
- Drivers Door **MUST** be reinforced. Door may be welded, but **ONLY THE DRIVER'S DOOR.** Some type of bar or pipe is also required. Also up to a 3" pipe can be placed behind the driver's seat from "door post to door post"
- PICKUPS 2x4**
 - RUBBER SUBSTANCE/CUSHION MUST** be placed between cab and box.
 - Tailgate must be chained or cabled. **NO WELDING.**
 - NO** Hitches.
 - Boxes should be bolted to the cab.
 - Bar installed behind driver seat is strongly suggested, but no bigger than 3" diameter.
 - Boxes must be cleaned from all debris.
 - NO 4x4 OR 3/4 TON CONVERSIONS** – 2 wheel drive 1/2 ton Pickups **ONLY.**
- COMPACTS**
 - It is highly recommended to install a pipe, "3 Max" behind the driver's seat from door post to door post.
 - 4 and 6 cylinder engines only.
 - 107" maximum wheel base.
 - May also install a pipe under steering column from door post to door post, but no boxing in.
 - Original gas tank can be used, but must be securely placed in the back seat and wired up with an electric shut-off properly marked.
- OUTLAW CLASS**
 - 1/2 Ton – 3/4 Ton Pickups, Suburbans, Blazers, Broncos
 - Front Drive Shaft will be **REMOVED**, and not **REINSTALLED AT ANY TIME.**
 - All other rules from the 2x4 Pickups still apply.
- Slogans, Advertising, and or Printing can be placed anywhere on the vehicle other than the front Driver's and Passenger Doors. They will require your Number and Name. **KEEP A "G" RATING.**
- Stay in your vehicle at all times, keep your helmet on, hands and arms inside, and seatbelt fastened, unless you are told by the Head Flag Man or Safety Personnel.
- All Vehicles will have a stick taped to it before it enters the arena. When you are no longer able to move or have been disqualified, "**REMOVE YOUR STICK**". If stick is up, it means you are still able to hit.
- If You Think It Is Illegal, **DON'T DO IT!**
- WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MODIFY OR CHANGE ANY OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS AS WE FEEL NEEDED.**
