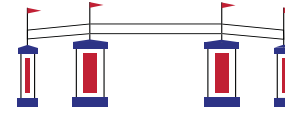

DEMOLITION DERBY OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS

- Drivers must be 16 years or older
- Everyone under the age of 18 will need a signed consent from parent or legal guardian.
- No one under the age of 14 will be allowed in the pits for "safety and insurance situations".**
- No deliberate head-ons or hitting opponent's driver door. **AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION.**
- NO** sandbagging or pussy footing. If so, the demo will be stopped and a big "P" will be placed on the vehicle and everyone left running may have one free shot at you and the demo will start again.
- NO** feeding the driver's door. If so, the other driver will not be disqualified.
- Drivers may maneuver forward and backwards.
- No team driving.
- The decisions of the officials are **FINAL.**
- Only the driver will be allowed to approach the officials with a disagreement.
- All drivers must attend the drivers' meeting.
- All red flags will be left up to Head Flag Man and Fire Personnel to proceed.**
- GREEN** means GO . . . **RED** means STOP . . . **BLACK** means you are disqualified "**DONE**".
- Last hit counts for a win — **NOT necessarily the last one running.**
- Maximum of 8 vehicles per heat. The top 3 drivers will advance.
- Check In:** Must be in line fifteen minutes prior to gate closing (6:30), or a \$20.00 late fee will be assessed.
- Pit gate opens at 4:00 P.M. Gates close at 7:00 P.M. Drivers' meeting at 7:15 P.M. Showtime 7:30 P.M.**
- ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PITS BY BOTH THE DRIVER AND ANYONE ELSE IN THEIR PIT!** Anyone observed using or under the influence of either alcohol or a controlled substance will be immediately disqualified and banned from the pits and will forfeit all winnings and entry fees. Violators may be turned into local law enforcement!!!
- One red flag will be allowed for each driver, at the discretion of the flagman and safety personnel.

GENERAL SAFETY AND VEHICLES RULES

- All drivers must wear a safety helmet and eye protection.
- Seat belts **MUST** be worn at all times while driver is in car. Belt must be fastened to the frame.
- ALL GLASS MUST** be removed including headlights and tail lights.
- The rear seat **MUST** be removed.
- Radiators and fans may be removed but **NOT** relocated.
- Batteries **MUST** be relocated to a secure area and covered.
- Roll over bars are allowed, but not necessary — **NO STRUCTURAL STRENGTH**
- Bumpers and fenders may be trimmed, but not altered.
- No bent over hoods — "only factory hood placement".**
- No special bumpers, extra weights, trailer hitches, special lifts, tire chains, etc.
- Driver's door **MUST** be reinforced, pipe/bar etc., up to 3" tubing may be installed directly behind driver's seat "from door post to door post". **ALL OTHER REINFORCING, WELDING, OR BOLTING IS PROHIBITED OTHER THAN THE DRIVER'S DOOR.**

- Original fuel tank **MUST** be removed, and new tank relocated and secured. Max of 3 gallons of gas.
- Any loose chrome moldings should be removed for "driver's safety".
- Access to engine compartment for fire suppression is required — 18" hole minimum.
- All air bags **MUST** be removed or disconnected.
- NO** fluorescent or red paint on rims and/or tires.
- Any air conditioning refrigerant must be removed.
- Electric fuel pumps permitted if safely placed and a shoot-off switch is accessible and properly made.
- Transmission coolers are permitted.
- Engines and bumpers must be stock to vehicle and year.
- Up to **TWO** places of ready rod may be placed on the hood and welded to the frame.
- PICKUPS 2X4**
 - Rubber substance/cushion **MUST** be placed between cab and box — "driver's safety".
 - 4 points of chaining or cabling will be allowed on tailgates. **NO** welding.
 - Factory suspension only! "Stock"
 - No hitches.
 - Keep bumpers stock and in stock position.
 - Boxes must be bolted to cab.
 - Bar installed behind driver seat is strongly suggested no bigger than 3" in diameter.
 - Boxes must be cleaned of all loose debris.
 - NO 4x4 or 3/4 ton conversions — 2 wheel drive, 1/2 ton pickups ONLY.**
- IMPACTS**
 - It is mandatory to have a heavy steel pipe/bar installed along driver's door.
 - A pipe behind driver's door — "door post to door post".
 - 4 or 6 cylinder engines only.
 - 107" wheel base.
 - May install a pipe from door post to door post under steering column, but no boxing in "driver's safety"
- OUTLAW CLASS**
 - 1 1/2 Ton, 3/4 Ton, Pickup, Suburban, Blazer styles will be allowed.
 - Front drive shaft must be removed and not reinstalled at any time.
 - All rules from regular pickup still remain in place also.
- Slogans, advertising or printing may be placed anywhere **EXCEPT** the front doors. The driver's name and number **MUST** be on both front doors — "you choose your own number".
- Stay in your vehicle during your heat unless told different — keep your seatbelt fastened and helmet on.
- All drivers will have a stick taped to their vehicles before entering the arena. When your vehicle is no longer able to run or move, or "disqualified", you remove your stick. This will allow others to know that you are either still competing or not. Stick up means you are **FREE** to hit.
- Any rules and/or regulations not covered will be left to the officials. **IF YOU THINK IT IS ILLEGAL, DON'T DO IT!!!**
