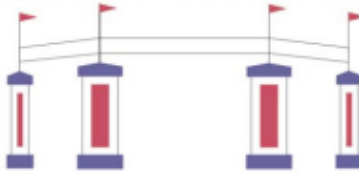


MARSHALL COUNTY FAIR



25th Marshall County Fair Parade Wednesday, July 21, 2021 6:00 p.m.

The time has come again for the kick-off parade for the Marshall County Fair. The response we have had in the past 25 years has been fantastic. We hope that you will join us again this year and showcase yourself in the Marshall County Fair Kick-Off Parade on Wednesday, July 21, 2021.

To registration for the parade: simply fill out the form and return it to the address below, or fill out the online registration on our website at <http://www.marshallcountyfair.org/> There is no registration fee for the Marshall County Fair Parade. Registrations forms are prioritized by the order in which they are received. The earlier we receive your registration the closer to the front of the parade your parade entry will be. Your parade ***number will be sent out to you two weeks before the parade.*** ***Registration deadline is Friday, July 16, 2021.*** No registrations will be accepted after that date. ***Please display your number on the left hand side of your unit so the judges can see it.*** Winners will be posted at the fair office on the fairgrounds later that evening. Checks will be mailed to the winners.

As in years past we will line up behind the Warren Alvarado Oslo schools. There will be a fair official in front of the High School directing you to your assigned spot. Parking is tight, stay as close to your number as possible. Stakes with your number will be along the highway and around the school. The parade will again start behind the High School, proceed down the west side of the city buildings straight north to Johnson Ave., then east to the fairgrounds. There are restroom facilities south of the school in proximity to the football field.

Parade guidelines:

- No candy or other objects can be thrown from the vehicles. Walkers are encouraged to hand out candy.***
- Absolutely NO throwing of water balloons and or shooting of water guns.***
- The parade will go on rain or shine. In case of severe weather, it would be cancelled.***

If you are interested in driving your classic car in front of the spectators, we will have a separate running of classic cars 15 minutes before the parade starts. There will be no prizes awarded but you will drive the route at your own speed. Classic cars will line up on the north side of the courthouse.

We hope you will join us for another fun evening at the Marshall County Fair. We look forward to receiving your registrations.
