



**28th Marshall County Fair Parade
Wednesday, July 24, 2024 6:00 p.m.**

The time has come again for the kick-off parade for the Marshall County Fair. The response we have had in the past 27 years has been fantastic. We hope that you will join us again this year and showcase yourself in the Marshall County Fair Kick-Off Parade on Wednesday, July 24, 2024.

There is no registration fee for the Marshall County Fair Parade. Registration forms are prioritized by the order in which they are received from our website. The earlier we receive your registration the closer to the front of the parade your parade entry will be. ***Your parade number will be sent out to you two weeks before the parade. Registration deadline is Monday, July 22, 2024.*** No registrations will be accepted after that date. ***Please display your number on the left hand side of your unit so the judges can see it.*** Winners will be posted at the fair office on the fairgrounds later that evening. Checks will be mailed to the winners.

Due to the construction at the Warren Alvarado Oslo High School, the staging area has been changed to the south parking lot of the Marshall County Fairgrounds. There will be a fair official in front of the area directing you to your assigned spot. Parking is tight, stay as close to your number as possible. Stakes with your number will be along the staging area. The parade will start from the staging area and proceed down to the fair gates and straight west down Johnson Avenue to 1st street, then south to Highway 1. There are restroom facilities near the campground and rusty gate arena.

Parade guidelines:

- ***No candy or other objects can be thrown from the vehicles.***
- ***Walkers are encouraged to hand out candy.***
- ***Absolutely NO throwing of water balloons and or shooting of water guns.***
- ***The parade will go on rain or shine. In case of severe weather, it would be canceled.***

If you are interested in driving your classic car in front of the spectators, we will have a separate running of classic cars 15 minutes before the parade starts. There will be no prizes awarded but you will drive the route at your own speed. Classic cars will line up in front of the fair gate.

We hope you will join us for another fun evening at the Marshall County Fair. We look forward to receiving your registrations.
