



## Marshall County Fair Baja Rules 2019

- Roll bar shall be no more than 6" from drivers head horizontally and must stick up higher than drivers head with helmet on. This will be enforced!
- Roll cage inside of car, 3 or 4 point roll bar of 2" or larger pipe bolted to the floor with plates on each side.
- Battery can remain in stock location or safely relocated.

If relocated to cab must be securely fastened and covered.

- Gas tank stock position or safely relocated.

If in stock location make sure that factory straps are still securely mounted or add some.

- Glass

Remove lights front and rear.

Side windows rolled down. Recommend removing

Windshield can stay in if removed a helmet with a full face shield is required.

Drivers and passenger side mirrors must be removed.

Also recommend putting bars in front of driver to block debris.

- Drivers door-protected with a bar or beam.
- Tires stock or approved highway tires.
- Sun roof must be covered with metal equal to roof metal.
- Drivers must wear helmet anytime the car is moving and/or on the track.

Seat belt with a shoulder strap also required.

- No passengers allowed.
- Number on car roof in the vertical position.
- Driver must have valid driver's license.

**16 & 17 years old must have release form signed by legal guardian.**

- No one under the age of 12 allowed in the pits.
- New vans and pickup class will be as follows.

Mini vans with no frame.

S-10 pickups, ford rangers, trail blazers, smaller ford explorers etc.

Call to verify vehicle entry into intended class as ruling of which class you are placed in, on race day will be up to race officials. **No exceptions!!!**
