

RULES & REGULATIONS

PLEASE REVIEW

General Rules

- ❖ Rules and Regulations will be strictly adhered to.
- ❖ Exhibits may be entered online from June 14 to July 14 for all classes.
- ❖ ONLINE REGISTRATION IS ENCOURAGED TO MINIMIZE DELAYS IN THE REGISTRATION PROCESS! Register online at www.marshallcountyfair.org.
 - Click on the Open Class Registration link. *Note the article regarding online registration.*
- ❖ **No entries will be accepted other than during Entry Day hours. (see end of rules)**
- ❖ Exhibitors please bring in only the articles listed in the Premium List. No specials can be accepted.
- ❖ Entry tags will be provided for each animal and/or exhibit stating the Division and Class.
 - Must be attached to the animal pen or exhibit until the close of the fair.
 - Entry tag will state the owner's name but is sealed until after judging.
- ❖ **All exhibits removed from the fairgrounds before 5:00pm Sunday July 25th, without notification of the superintendent, are subject to withholding of premiums.**
- ❖ The Association will take every precaution in its power for the preservation of articles and livestock on exhibition but can't be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur in the delivery, exhibition or removal of the exhibits.
- ❖ Superintendents have charge of the different entries.
 - Exhibitors can contact superintendents requesting information on a given exhibit.
- ❖ Awards shall be designated by stickers (ribbons may be obtained when vouchers are picked up) as follows: Grand Champion: Purple, First: Blue, Second: Red, Third: White, or no prize by comparing individual merits of entries.
- ❖ Grand Champion
 - You will be paid Grand Champion premium and not blue ribbon.
 - Ribbons will be given for the Grand Champion.
- ❖ Premium awards will be paid by vouchers. Please redeem your voucher at the Fair Office from 4:00PM - 6:30PM on the last day of the fair Exhibit can not be picked up before 5:00pm.
 - Can redeem within 30 days at Fair Office
 - **Vouchers not redeemed within 30 days will be null and void.**

OPEN CLASS

Department I - Q (all non-livestock)

- ❖ Department I-Q are to be brought to the Open Class building.
- ❖ All exhibits must be the work of, and owned by the exhibitor.
- ❖ If the projects exhibited is a set (towels, pillow case, etc.), please enter only one.
- ❖ **Any article which has been entered at a previous Marshall County Fair will not be eligible to compete again.**
- ❖ Entry tags
 - Department I-Q online (except class N) will be available from the Open Class registration desk.
 - Department N entry tags completed online will be at Settlers Square reception desk.
- ❖ Same Day entries Department I-Q will need to be processed at the Open Class registration desk.

LIVESTOCK
Department A-G (all livestock)

- ❖ To reserve animal stalling call Fair Office 218-745-4445
 - To ensure adequate space is available for all livestock.
- ❖ Animals must be brought to the appropriate building / with each entry appropriately tagged during Entry Day (see end of rules)
- ❖ Entry tags for department A-G will be available from the assigned superintendents in the livestock buildings.
 - You will not need to go to the Open Class registration desk unless changes are needed.
- ❖ Entries must be actual property of the exhibitor.
 - The age of the animal will be their actual age.
 - A certificate of registration will be required for registered divisions.
- ❖ Exhibitors of livestock must keep their stock, stalls and pens in good, neat condition and open for inspection from 10am to 10pm.
- ❖ All livestock including cattle, sheep, swine and goats will be examined by the official veterinarian each day of the fair.
- ❖ Certificates for all livestock consigned from other states shall comply with the rules and regulations of the Livestock Sanitary Board for the importation of livestock to Minnesota. With such further provisions as are required in the following sections for each species of livestock.
- ❖ All animals must be free of warts, ringworm or other contagious disease. If they arrive at the show with these diseases, they will be sent home.
- ❖ TB Health Rules - Only animals coming from the TB management zone must show proof of a negative TB test to exhibit at the Marshall County Fair.
- ❖ Anyone may exhibit livestock at the Marshall County Fair whose home county allows Marshall County residents to exhibit there.
- ❖ Additional classes may be added at the discretion of the superintendent, however no additional classes will be added for bulls that are not of the age listed for existing classes.
- ❖ Exhibitors should also be aware of any announcements made by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture and the Minnesota Department of Animal Health in regard to livestock exhibits and the spread of communicable diseases.

CATTLE

- ❖ Cattle will be shown by breeds, registered and grade will be shown together. Papers are required at entry time. No papers are required for grade cattle.
- ❖ All beef and dairy cattle must be tied in their stalls with a halter tie. No cattle are to be tied by leather show halters in stalls.
